International scientific **Petar Šarčević conferences** are organised biannually in honour of respectable legal scholar Professor Petar Šarčević, who is also known as one of the founding editors of the Yearbook of Private International Law. The speakers and participants of Petar Šarčević conferences are globally recognised legal experts, judges and advocate generals of the Court of Justice of the European Union (CJEU), as well as legal practitioners.

As emphasised by the New Consumer Agenda and recently adopted Digital Markets Act, the adjustment of consumer law and policy to digital transformation is one of the greatest challenges of the new digital era.

The most prominent **keynote** speakers will address the impact of digital transformation and of new technologies upon consumer law and protection. Professor **Geraint Howells** will discuss the role of online platforms in consumer protection and Professor **Hans-W. Micklitz** will address the consumer empowerment through legal tech.
