This call solicits essays in the field of the general theme of the conference from young scholars (PhD students, post-docs, adjunct professors, lecturers), provided that they have not held a tenure-track academic position before June 1, 2013 (*i.e.*, for more than 10 years as of June 1, 2023).

A **300-word abstract**, in Italian or in English, should be submitted by

In the email, the author should certify that she/he qualifies as a younger scholar.

The title of the file should be written as follows: **Family Name\_ First Name.doc**. The Organizing Committee shall acknowledge receipt and respond to all paper proposals submitted. Papers will be selected following rigorous peer review process by an Academic Committee composed by representatives from the Italian Association of Comparative Law, the Italian Society for Research in Comparative Law and the Comparative and European Public Law Association. Scholars whose papers have been accepted will need to register in advance at the conference.

Admitted into the Italian university system in 2011, the **Link Campus University** has a strong international vocation, actualized through the realization of various agreements with international universities, for the purpose of promoting the mobility of teachers and students.
