In the email, the author should certify that she/he qualifies as a younger scholar.

The title of the file should be written as follows: **Family Name_First Name.doc**. The Organizing Committee shall acknowledge receipt and respond to all paper proposals submitted. Papers will be selected following rigorous peer review process by an Academic Committee composed by representatives from the Italian Association of Comparative Law, the Italian Society for Research in Comparative Law and the Comparative and European Public Law Association. Scholars whose papers have been accepted will need to register in advance at the conference.
